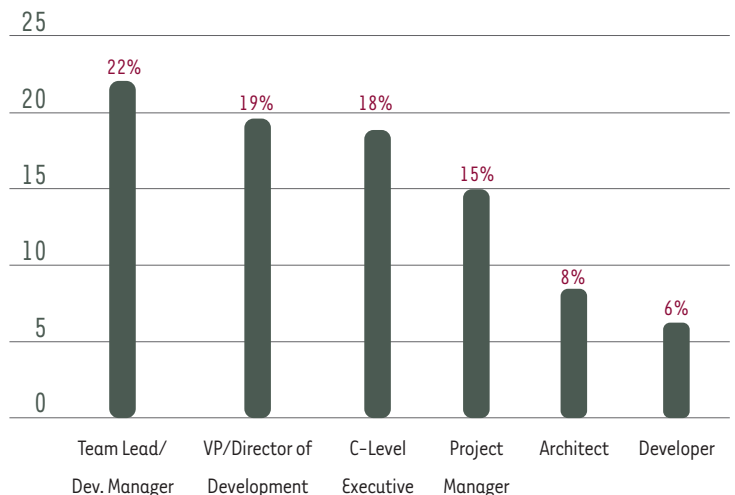

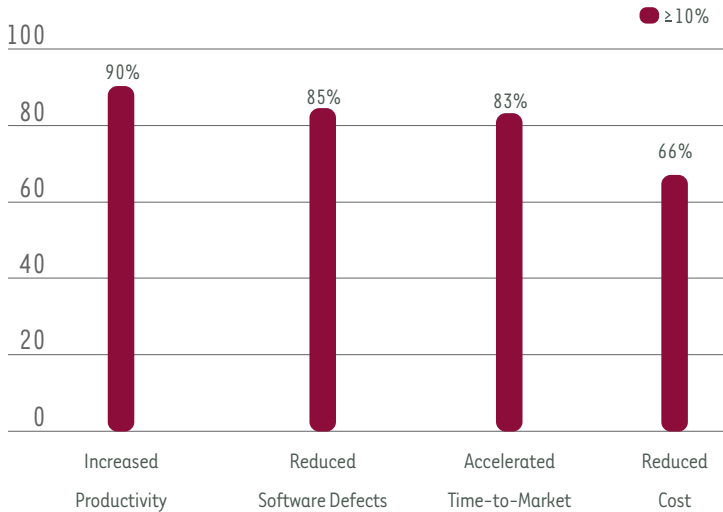

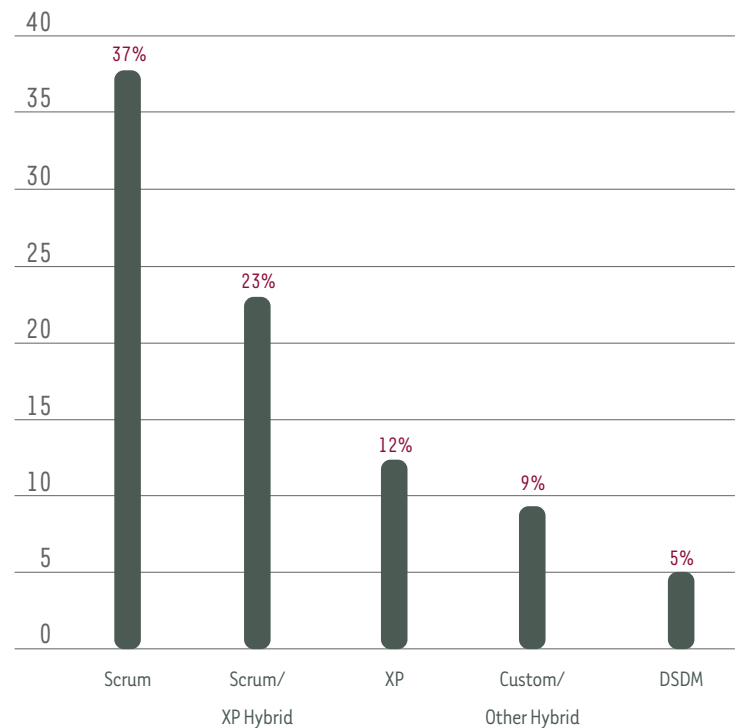

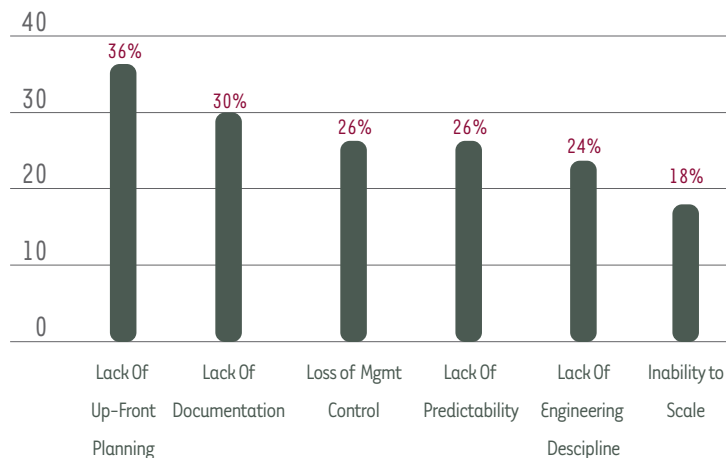

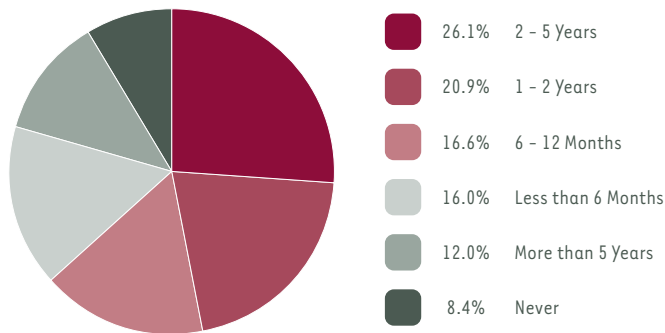

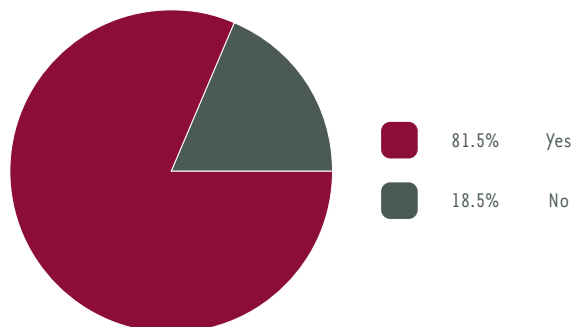
Which role below best describes your current position in your company?

Are you currently trying to implement Agile within your organization or thinking about doing so?



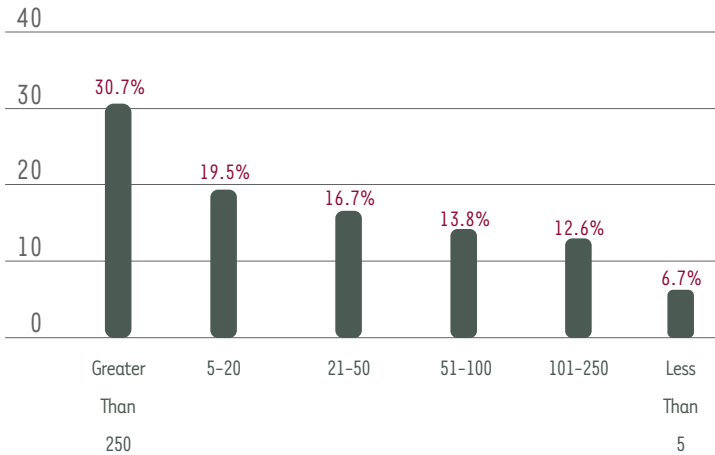
What situation below best describes your current level of exposure to agile development?

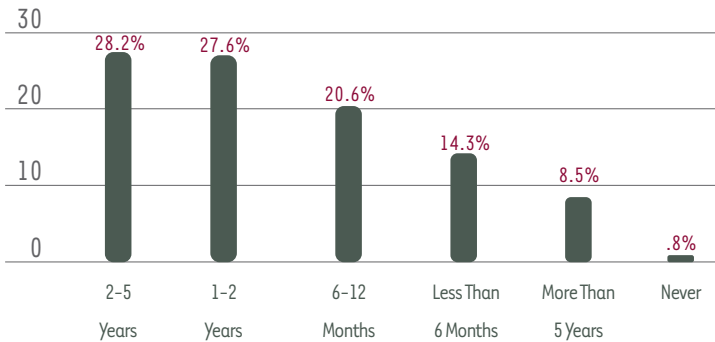

(including employees related to all aspects of software development and delivery)

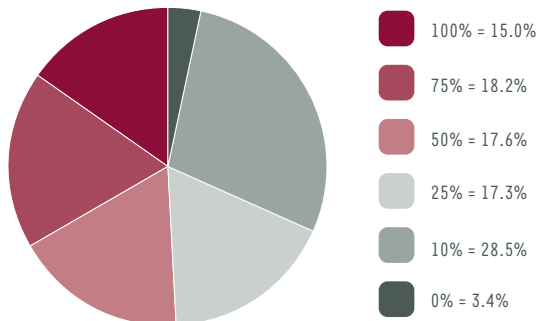


How long has your company been practicing Agile development methods?

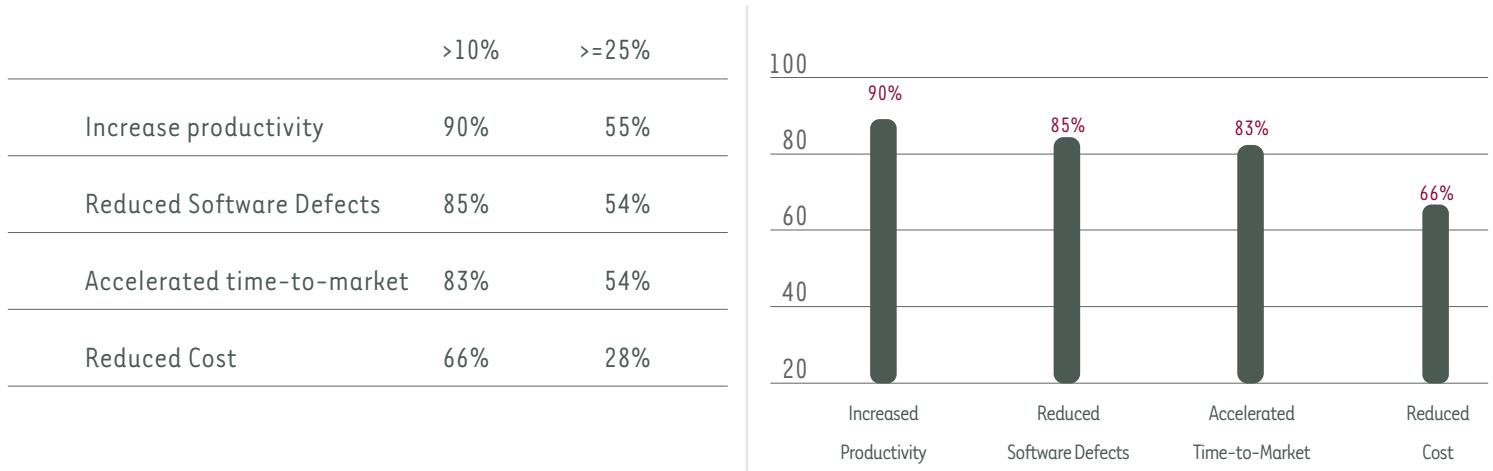

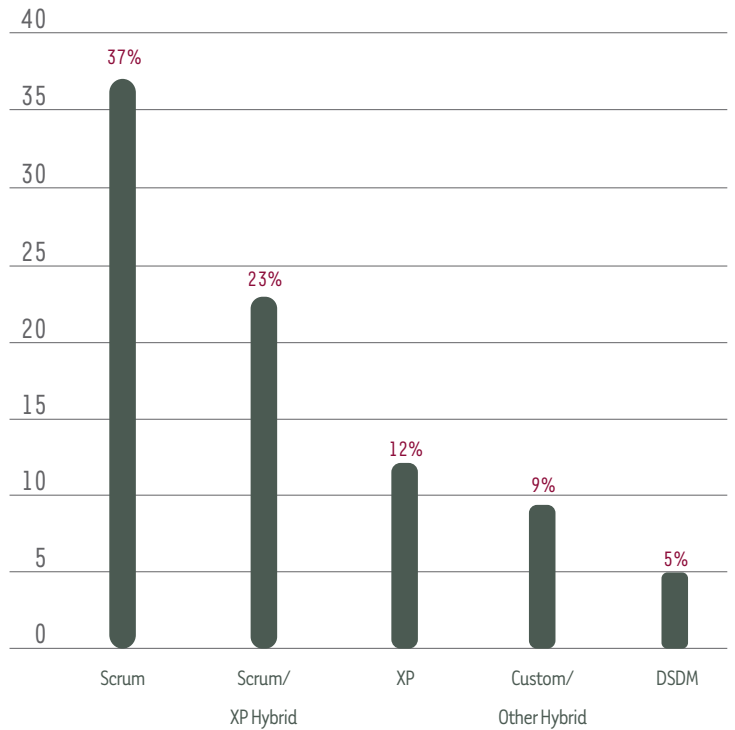

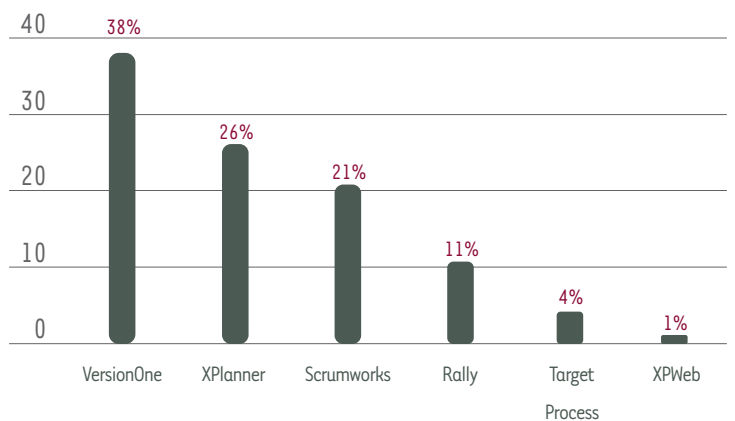
